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[2011] Global Health Course for Korean Leadership

- 2 hours per week for 15 weeks
- Attendees: Officials in Korean Government & Bilateral Agency related with Global Health (20 persons)
- At Seoul National University Hospital/College of Medicine

[2012] A Global Health Class in Social Medicine Semester Long Course

- 2 hours in a postgraduate course (Once)
- Credit course
- Attendees: 20 MS/PhD students
- Audit: Officials in Korean Government (5 persons)

[2013] A Global Health Course as one of the Social Medicine Course Series

- 3 hours per week for 15 weeks
- In a postgraduate course
- Credit course
- Attendees
 - 20 students in master or doctoral course students from diverse disciplines
- Audit
 - Officials in Korean Government or Bilateral Agencies (30 persons)
 - Professors, Physicians, and Nurses of several hospitals (50 persons)

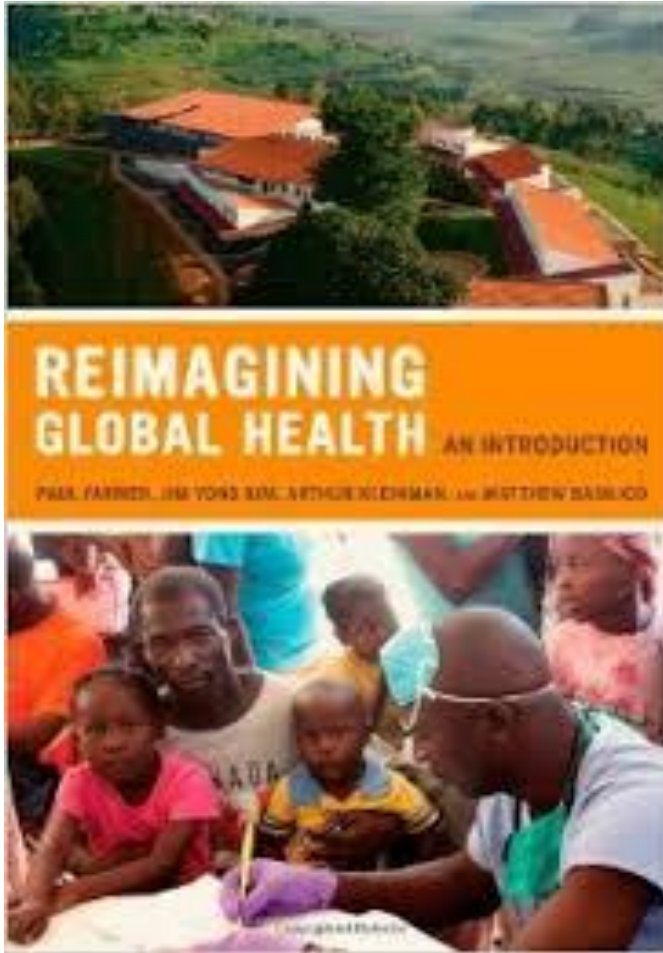
[2013] A Special Global Health Course for Officials from Ministry of Health of LMICs

- 200 hours per a course (4 month)
- In a postgraduate course
- Non-credit course
- Funded by Korean government for the scholarship
- Attendees
 - 6 to 18 mid-career officials per every year since 2013

[2014] Global Health Course for Pre-med students

- 2 hours per a week (fall semester)
- 15 weeks
- as a premed major selective course
- Title: Understanding Global Health
- equivalent to Global Health 101 class in US
- credit course
- Attendees
 - 25 pre-med students since 2014

- Global Health Law (15 weeks)

[2016] Global Health Classes in Medical course

- 2 hours
- Contents: globalization and health
- As one class of social medicine course
- in 1st year med students
- Credit course
- Mandatory class
- Attendees
 - 150 all 1st year medical students

[2017] Global Health Classes in Medical course

- 12 hours
- Contents: GBD and PHC, GH Actors
- As two day classes in social medicine course
- 2nd year med students
- Credit course
- Mandatory class
- Attendees
 - 150 all 2nd year medical students

[2017] Year-long Global Health Class

- 3 hours per week
- Every week for 2 consecutive semester
- Contents: M&E
- Credit course
- Postgraduate course
- Attendees
 - 10 master and PhD students
- Audit
 - 5 officers from Korean bilateral agency (office of evaluation)
 - 5 audit students

[2017] Global Health Classes in Medical course

- 4 hours per every other Thursday (16 hours in total)
- Spring semester
- Contents: Deep dive in health in a country of LMICs
- Title: **Becoming a honorary consular of my favorite country**
- Selective course
- 2nd year med students
- Credit course
- Attendee: Fifteen 2nd year medical students

[2017] Global Health Research Course

- 8 hours per day for 10 weeks
- Contents: Mixed method based student-driven research capacity building course
- Credit course
- Medical course (2nd year med students)
- Fall semester
- Selective
- Attendees
 - Four 2nd year med students

[2018] Global Health Practicum

- 5 weeks
- in 4th year med students
- Contents: overseas practicum in Caribbean and Africa
- Credit course
- Medical course (4th year med students)
- Attendees
 - 10 med students
