Dr. Harriet Nuwagaba-Biribonwoha

Dr. Harriet Nuwagaba-Biribonwoha is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Epidemiology at Columbia University Mailman School of Public Health (MSPH). She is a medical doctor and Rhodes Scholar with a PhD in Epidemiology, working as Research Director at ICAP in Swaziland. She is the Principal Investigator for a CDC/PEPFAR award to strengthen national epidemiological and research capacity in Swaziland.

Dr. Nuwagaba-Biribonwoha established the Health Research Training Program (H RTP), a health research mentorship initiative for local healthcare workers in government departments, which has benefited a total of 30 fellows. She regularly hosts MSPH students on international placements. Previously, Dr. Nuwagaba-Biribonwoha coordinated ICAP research and program evaluations in 8 countries in East and Southern Africa. Before ICAP, she coordinated clinical trials for the Medical Research Council Clinical Trials Unit (MRC-CTU) in the United Kingdom and practiced as a medical doctor in Uganda.
