

ADVOCACY STRATEGY=THE PLAN

- HAVE A CLEAR GOAL
- > CLEAR ASK
- > IDENTIFY WHO TO TARGET: public & politicians, influencers (the movables)
- > TACTICS= what you will do to implement the plan

ADVOCACY TACTICS

- ENGAGE THE PUBLIC & POLICYMAKERS
- IDENTIFY ALLIES, OPPONENTS & MOVEABLES
- ENGAGE LOCALLY
- > MESSAGE
- DEVELOP YOUR MATERIAL
- PLATFORMS- social media, traditional media, public meetings, use your networks
- SEE WWW.RESULTS.ORG
- > THE PUBLIC MOVES THE POLITICAL
- EFFECTIVE ADVOCACY = STRONG RELATIONSHIPS

- BE POSITIVE

CUGH's Response to Gun Violence

- Press releases and the Gun Control Tracker
- The Tracker identifies supporters and opponents of gun control in the US Congress
- GOAL: reduce the number of people shot in the US = 100,000/ year (32,000 die)


