- Rapid Increase: 250% increase in older adults is projected in developing countries.
- Ghana's Case: The elderly population is expected to reach 14% by 2050 (900%) since increase independence).
- Critical Concern: Readiness of African healthcare systems, particularly in rural areas

### **Critical Gaps**


- No specialized geriatricians





Fig. 1 – Study methodology and flow of research
